











City Hall Park has had many names - and forms - since its inception, but these are the key character-defining features that have been constant:












2012 Concept Plan Imagine City Hall Park

2018 City Hall Park Landscape Design Refinements since December 2016 DAB

Preservation Burlington, Preservation Trust & SHPO recommendations:

- Creation of more defined central space.
- Future Vertical Element in Central Plaza.
- Remove second diagonal walk.
- Primary Arc Walk is straightened (less curve).
- Walks more radial.

Refined design program & materials

- Removed Terraces from City Hall.
- · Reduced quantity of highest finish materials.
- Added bathroom & drinking fountain along Park Lane
- Removed Kiosk structure to a future phase.

Refined green infrastructure throughout the park

- Rain Gardens (3)
- Cobblestone Runnels (conveyance)
- Permeable Pavers

Refined lighting

- New fixtures throughout Park to preserve historic character
- Inground fixtures & accent lighting to illuminate the façade of Firehouse, City Hall and its entry medallion.

























Radiating Paths Central Plaza w/ Fountain

Feature

Entrance at Corner of Main & St. Paul St.



Rain garden with seat wall & native plantings at corner entrance

Linear seat/ retaining wall with steps along Main Street Edge

Linear rain garden with stepping stone "bridges" & native plantings behind wall along Main St.

Benches & lighting along main walk

Cobblestone runnel to convey stormwater & reduce soil erosion potential

Open lawn area for informal play & temporary art installations

2018 City Hall Park Landscape Design Entrance at Corner of College & St. Paul St.



New tree, perennial & annual plantings and seating at corner of College & St. Paul St.

Created a paved entry space to welcome people into the park and accommodates pedestrian movement at the corner.

Bark mulch path through plantings to access monument

Increased plantings along College St.

Benches & barrier fence to protect plantings along College St. & reduce soil compaction from high pedestrian use.

Benches & trash receptacle along main walk

Open lawn areas for informal play and temporary art installations

Raingarden at mid block crossing entrance

Public bulletin board and bicycle parking at mid block crossing









15' wide Park Lane with permeable pavers


Perennial plantings around historic monument & flag pole

New trees, shrubs & perennial plantings to surround plaza area.


